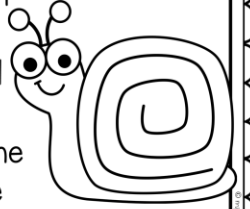
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Jack the Snail

3. What is Penny's pool bigger than?

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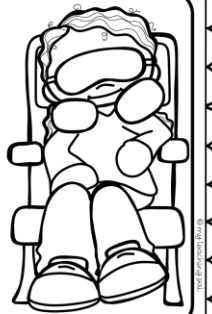
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Leo's Flight

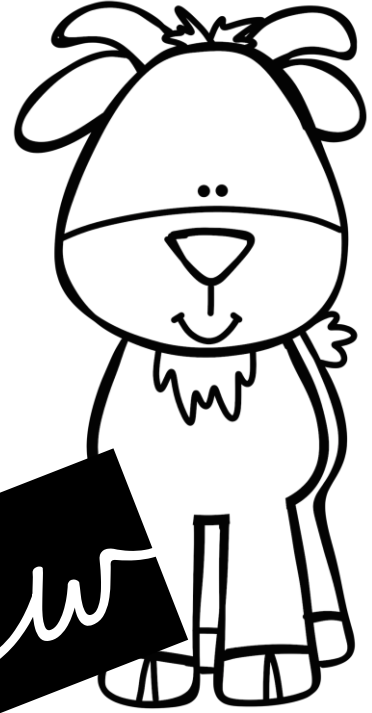
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The Old Goat

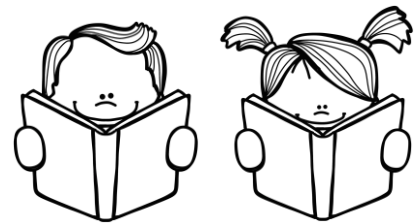

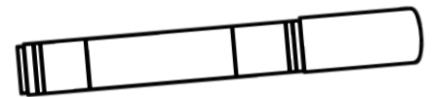
1. Read the text 3 times. Color a star each time.
